Rotorua takes a step forward with FOGO

Rotorua Lakes Council is taking an important step toward reducing emissions and managing waste more sustainably with the introduction of its Food Organics and Green Organics (FOGO) service from July 2026.

Food and garden waste makes up more than half of what we throw away. Through FOGO, around 6,000 tonnes of organic material will be diverted from landfill each year and instead transformed into renewable energy and nutrient-rich fertiliser at Ecogas.

FOGO is a practical, future-focused solution that keeps valuable resources in use, reduces emissions, and supports a more circular approach to waste management.

We're proud to support this initiative and work alongside Rotorua Lakes Council to deliver real environmental and community benefits for the region.
