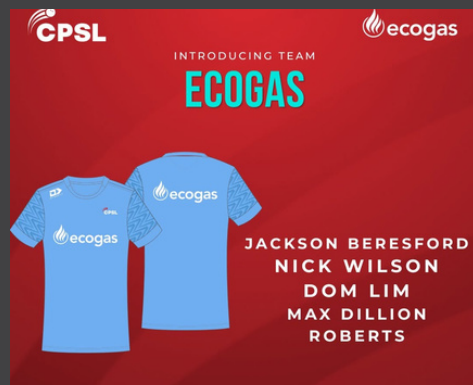
It was a positive early-stage conversation that we look forward to progressing.
