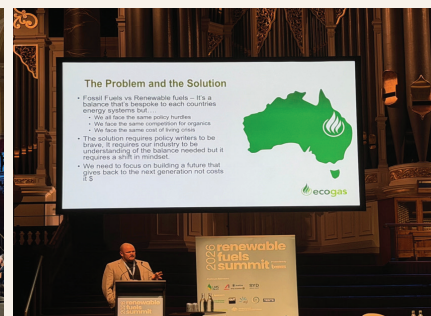
Welcome to Ecogas News, our monthly newsletter sharing the latest from Ecogas Reporoa and Christchurch.
