Our Chief Technology Officer, Dr Alzbeta Bouskova Houghton, was a keynote speaker at the AORA - Australian Organics Recycling Association Limited Conference, sharing insights and learning alongside leaders from across the organics and resource recovery sector.

Key themes from the conference included reducing contamination in organics collections and creating stronger circular connections between organic waste suppliers and the products created from them.

One thing was clear: anaerobic digestion continues to be underrepresented in our region, despite the major role it can play in emissions reduction, renewable energy, and circular resource recovery.

It was encouraging to see international discussions reinforce the work already happening at Ecogas and the strength of our Christchurch facility design within the New Zealand context.

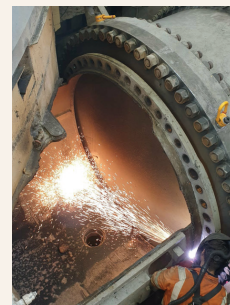


Ecogas Christchurch Site Open Day
